Results Report will be reviewed at Dec. meeting, key themes and highlights

AB Ed requires schools to present provincial achievement results to parents. Science and LA were not done last year due to the school piloting the new science curriculum and language/math was an optional implementation year and they did not write a provincial exam. Social Studies results were reviewed. No one below acceptable standard. 100% acceptable, 40% standard of excellence. 2022/23 the school was able to return to a pre-covid balance in subjects and the school is happy with the results.
