6.3 Miss Corrine and Miss Terra's monthly report

September recap- school spirit day assembly – going to start doing assemblies on every school spirit day, color days with zones of regulation, leadership academy – teachers co-planned 9 days of leadership skills we want our students to be learning, GPPSD fun run – great turnout for Parkside, AGM for School Council & Fundraising Guild, 123s have started great lessons, school photos, Truth & reconciliation/Parkside T&R Art Walk, Corrine went with Laura for recognition at the board level re: the Prime Minister's Excellence in Teaching award that she was presented last June. Indigenous drummer and storyteller Al Crawford gave assembly presentation, some of school clubs have started up again. Students reacclimating to routines in classroom. Started assessments, classroom and school culture building. First PL day - significant portion of that was for the 3 year ed plan.

In Oct. more evac drills, hot lunch, dress as a teacher day, rooted connections art and artifacts display will be at the school until Nov. 10th, very excited to have that. Thanksgiving, read-a-thon, first MALT on Oct. 23 (Multi Activity Learning Time) another PL day and Halloween costume day/events.

7.0 Trustee's Report-Joan Nellis Trustee Liaison

Used to be in Parent Council before she was a trustee, values the role of School Council greatly. Feel free to make use of my role, ask questions at meetings or email through Corrine.

Return of summer school gave flexibility to students who needed credits to graduate. Pilot return was very successful. Advise council to expect school council year planning resource that will help with benchmarks and goals. Confirmed we've been given resources re: school messenger. Bussing: ZPass being replaced with a new program "Zonar" which will roll out soon. Since Sept. met with two local MLAs to educate them on realities in division and the capital needs. Also had a meeting with the Minister of Ed which the MLAs attended. The opinion of the board is that if the MLAs are advocates for the trustees, it's better for everyone. Trustee Chairs & Superintendents across the province had another opportunity to meet with the Minister of Education – workshopped solutions to funding issues. Was great to have solution based conversations with them. This is the first Minister of Ed that has utilized sessions in this way and they are invaluable as we see changes come out of them directly. Discussed testing and the timing of testing, Minister of Ed has requested testing for Kindergarten and Gr. 1 which provides great information, but they were brought in for the first month of school, which did not feel like the best timing. Celebrated Miss Laura at the last meeting re: Prime Minister's award.
